Oculus Pathology Lab Delivers Faster Results for Central Texas Health System

Partnership With Oculus Pathology Facilitates Faster Treatment Initiation

A large Texas health care system began partnering with the Oculus Pathology Lab in July 2022. The system also has onsite labs at two of its facilities and uses the Oculus Pathology Lab in addition to its own internal resources.

The partnership has significantly reduced turnaround times for pathology testing -- delivering results faster for physicians and patients.

The health system uses a nationally standardized reporting template from the College of American Pathologists and lab information system-integrated voice recognition system to expedite delivery of the pathology report. The Oculus Pathology Lab immediately adopted these tools to provide a seamless experience for the health system's providers and have additional resources to accelerate the delivery of pathology reports to clinicians.

The Oculus Pathology Difference



Prior to working with the Oculus Pathology lab, we had to send our larger specimens to another facility for gross examination (a critical step in the pathology assessment) This delayed the testing process.

With Oculus Pathology, we have reduced the turnaround time for large specimen testing by two to three days because the lab has pathologists' assistants trained to perform macroscopic exams. We've also reduced the turnaround time for breast biopsies by three to four days because the Oculus Pathology lab performs ImmunoHistoChemistry processes faster than the previous reference lab.
